- Submitter Information
- Nominee Information
- Authorization from the superintendent, board president and board members

BEST PRACTICES

- Gather all necessary information before beginning your nomination application.
- Apply early so if any of the criteria is missing, CSBA staff can contact you and allow you to submit the missing piece(s) prior to the **June 28, 2024**, submission deadline.







NOMINATIONS OPEN

Nominations for the Golden Quill Awards **open on April 1**. Visit the Golden Quill Awards website to learn about the award criteria, application process and award benefits.



NOMINATIONS DUE

Nominations **close on June 28**, giving submitters three months to submit their nominations online via the Entry Form link on the website.



WINNERS SELECTED

In October, nominators will be notified about the status of their nominations. They will be provided with instructions about awarding their nominees.



RECOGNITION

In December, winners will be invited to attend the 2nd General Session held during the CSBA Annual Education Conference and Trade Show (AEC) so they can be present for the announcement of their win.



SAMPLE PRESS RELEASE AND WINNER'S KIT

After AEC, winners will receive an email containing a sample press release and a winner's kit.



AWARD BENEFITS

Winners will be listed on the Golden Quill Awards website and featured in the winter issue of the CSBA *California Schools* magazine.
